The State of the Foundation

After twenty-five years of operation, the foundation is sovereign and maintaining through strength of purpose and to the ideals which our founder, the distinguished evangelist, Dr. J. S. Winston, Sr., envisioned: that in the spirit of Christ we operate in the domain of spiritual integrity.

We seek to help change lives through the process of assisting in providing a Christian education to committed young men and women, those who are giving their lives to the promotion of the preaching and teaching of the Word of God as opportunities present themselves.

It is for that reason I am pleased to announce that the Foundation's Board of Directors has approved scholarships for the nine students requesting financial assistance for the 2007-2008 school year. The Foundation awards \$1,000.00 scholarships annually to between 10 and 20 students, who state that they could not be successful in completing their studies, were it not for the financial assistance we provide.

In fact, during the past twenty-five years, we have provided financial support to more than 100 students and generated more than \$500,000.00 to the support of our school, Southwestern Christian College.

Our most recent accomplishments include erecting a Student Cottage, thereby providing living quarters in the new Campus Housing Village and helping complete the infrastructure for eight more cottages with costs totaling \$314,357.53.

Our current challenges are to maintain our day-to-day operations, provide scholarships to needy students and pay down the \$200,000.00 original loan debt that was made to complete the much needed student housing for Ministerial students. It is for these reasons we are asking you to be liberal, please, in your giving today. Our financial goal this year is \$100,000.00.
