



## *Resume and Biographical Data of Dr. Clyde Muse*

**Clyde Muse was born September 1, 1928. He was raised by grandparents on a farm in Kingbury, Texas. He attended elementary and high school in San Antonio, Texas. In 1946, Clyde Muse joined the U.S. Air force and served for 7 years, 3 months and 22 days. On June 5, 1948, while serving in the armed forces, he married Lillian Adams, his grade school sweetheart; to this union nine children were born.**

**Brother Muse began his preaching career as a gospel minister in 1950 at the West laurel Church of Christ in San Antonio, Texas. he labored there until 1954 when he and his family moved to Louisville, kentucky where he preached for the Beech Street Church of Christ for several years.**

**While laboring for the Beech Street congregation, Brother Muse was asked to host a gospel meeting in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for the Church of Christ on Seventh and Massachusetts. After the engagement, being led by the Spirit of God, he soon began working for the Master at that congregation. A short time passed and the congregation moved to and began worshipping at the 36th and Prospect location. He preached there many years.**

**While hard-working and faithful in his work as a father and as a gospel preacher, Brother Muse had the fortitude to pursue and receive his doctoral degree in Philosophy at Oklahoma University. He wa the first African American to receive this level of education at Oklahoma University. This was an accomplishment to be noted due to his age, his level of spiritual dedication to the Lord's work and due to his responsibility to his family.**

**In September 1977, Dr. Clyde Muse fearlessly began the work as the minister of the Spencer Church of Christ in Oklahoma City. He has worked untiringly while at the Spencer congregation, hosting classes, knocking doors, spreading God's Word and building relationship for the cause of Christ. During his laboring at Spencer, Dr. Muse, an educator and a former member of the Oklahoma City School Board, taught Philosophy at Oklahoma Christian College (now a university). he is the author of the pamphlet, "The Cure for Chaos". Dr. Muse developed a dream to care for the elderly. With the help of others, he began to fight for this dream. After years of perseverance, the "Roscoe Dunjee Senior Living Center, sponsored by the Spencer Church of Christ, The Spencer Community of Hope and the National Benevolent Association, was constructed. Dr. Clyde Muse is respected and renowned scholar, teacher and preacher of the "True Gospel of Christ"**
